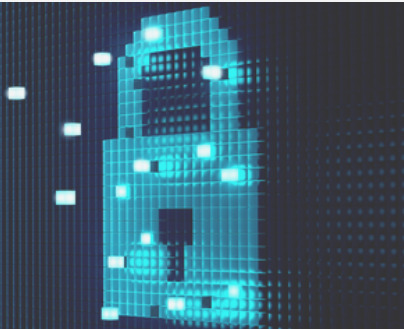

REQUIREMENTS OF A BUSINESS MEMBERSHIP

The Master Locksmiths Association works to protect and promote locksmiths in Australia and New Zealand. We are a connector, a lobbyist, an educator and a promoter, working tirelessly to ensure our trade remains successful and secure.

To make sure the public gets the best possible service and the highest quality work, all MLAA Master Locksmiths need to meet some basic requirements.

Registered Business

All Business Members of the MLAA need to be a registered business in Australia or New Zealand.

Trade Qualification

Individuals or Businesses applying for a MLAA Business Membership need to hold or employ specialists that hold at least a Certificate III in Locksmithing or an equivalent.

Licence or Police Check

Business Members need to be either Police Checked or hold a Security Licence in States where licensing is mandatory.

Insurance

Business Members must have minimum level of insurance that includes Public Liability Insurance with extensions for Errors & Omissions and Statutory Liability.

Code of Ethics

All Business Member are bound by our Constitution and By-Laws, incorporating our Code of Ethics and Code of Practice.

Membership Fees and any other income received by the Association, is reinvested into the projects undertaken by the Association to benefit and support its Members.

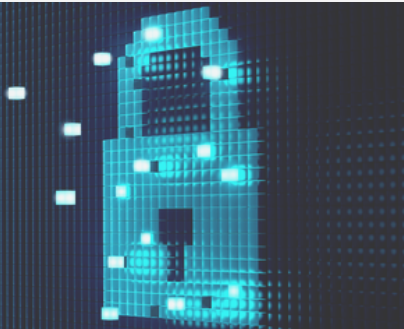
